Electrotypers frequently experience considerable and annoying difficulty from forms which have not been properly locked up. A proof from a form, taken after the quoins are pushed up with the fingers, may show every line straight and no displacement anywhere; afterwards, in finishing the lock-up, a tightening of the quoins with the mallet or the wrench will cause a derangement of lines and type at once unsafe and provoking.
