One of the peculiar features of this series is, that the lower-case letters B, D, H, M, N, P, Q and Y can be used to represent Q, P, Y, W, U, B, D and H; capital M makes W; figure 7 makes L, and figure 6 makes q, by merely inverting them—an important item to the printer when short of "sorts."
